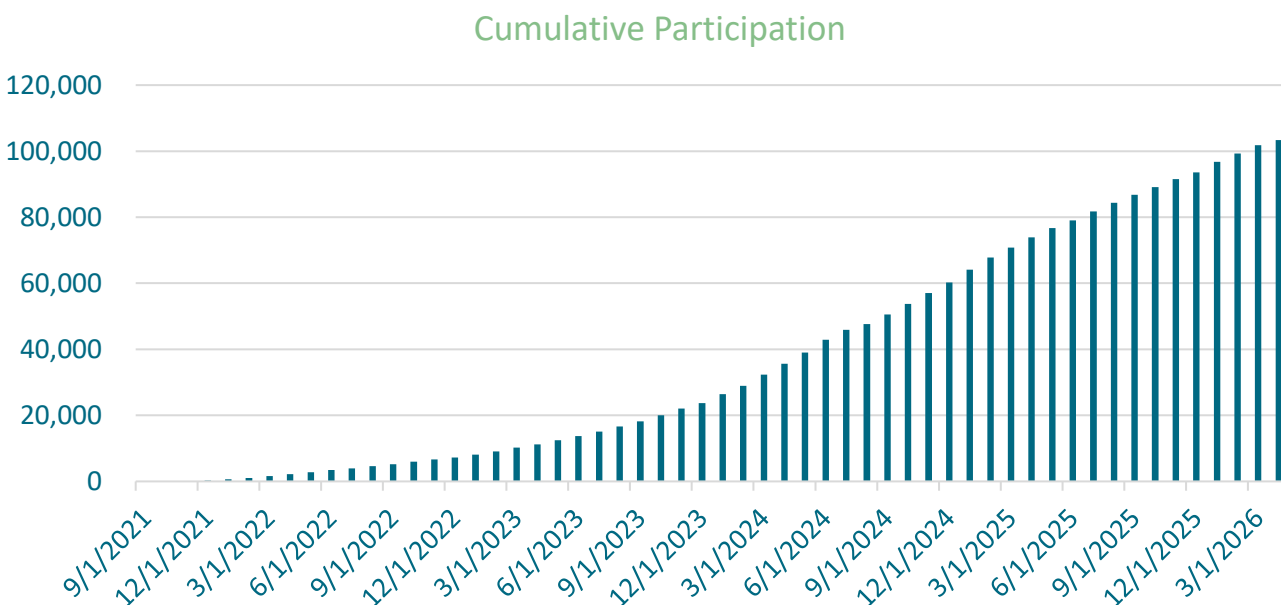

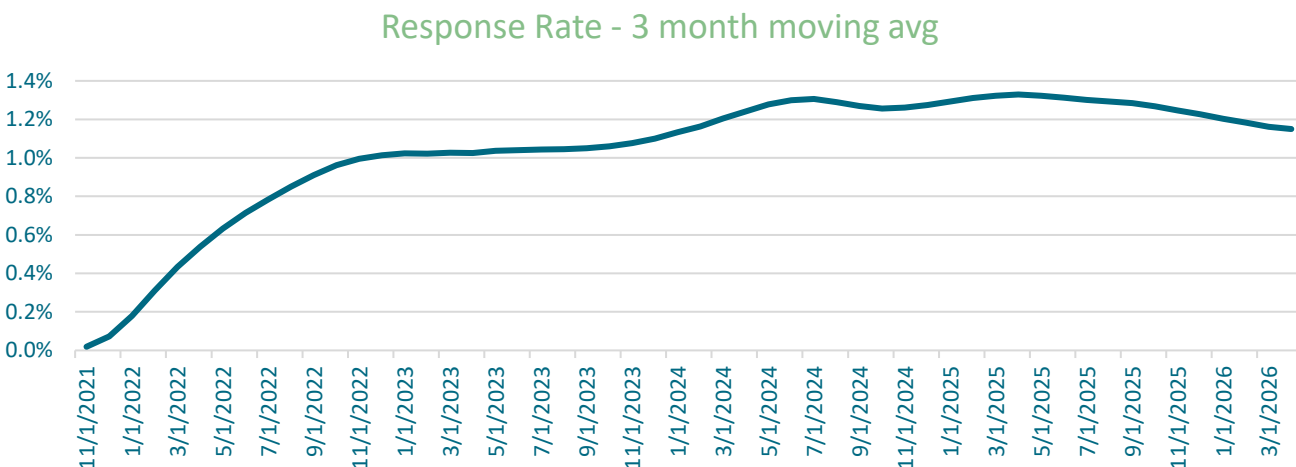
GentleCure.com Quiz Results

Updated: May 2026

In September 2021, GentleCure by SkinCure Oncology placed a brief 7-question survey on the GentleCure.com website.



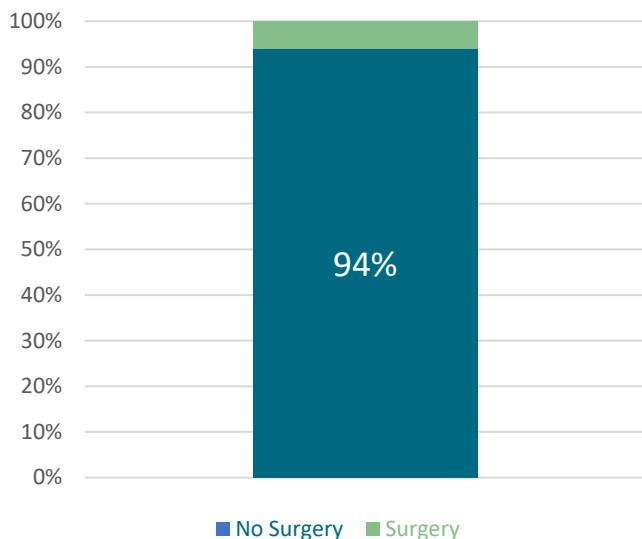
As of April 30, 2026, more than 103,000 visitors to the website completed the quiz.



Today, approximately 300,000 people visit the GentleCure.com website each month, and approximately 1.2% choose to take the quiz.

It's important to remember that all quiz participants have visited the GentleCure.com website, which attracts people newly diagnosed with skin cancer who are exploring treatment options. The responses to the quiz questions will not necessarily reflect the views and opinions of the public.

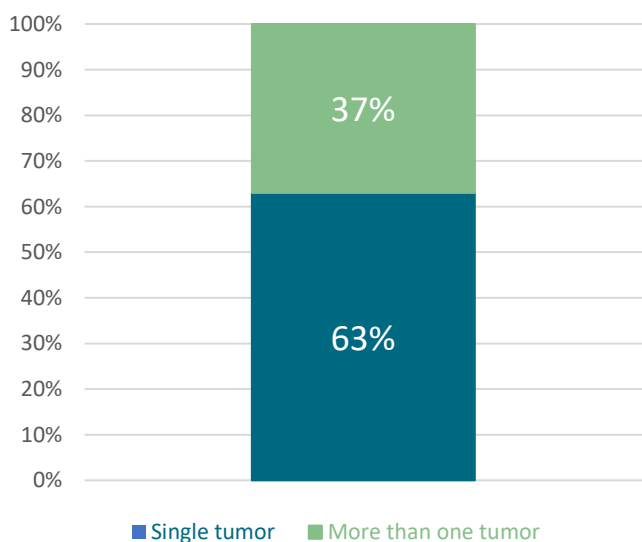
Question 1: Are you ok with having surgery, or would you prefer a treatment without surgery?



6% of respondents said that they would prefer a surgical treatment.

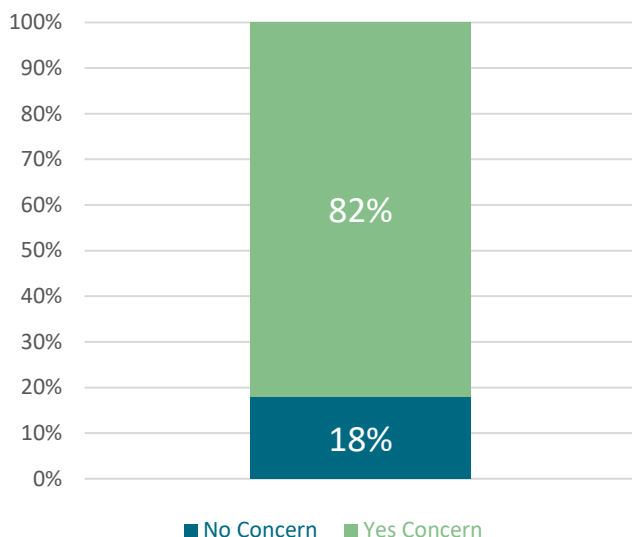
94% of respondents said that they would prefer a non-surgical treatment.

Question 2: Do you have multiple tumors that need to be treated?



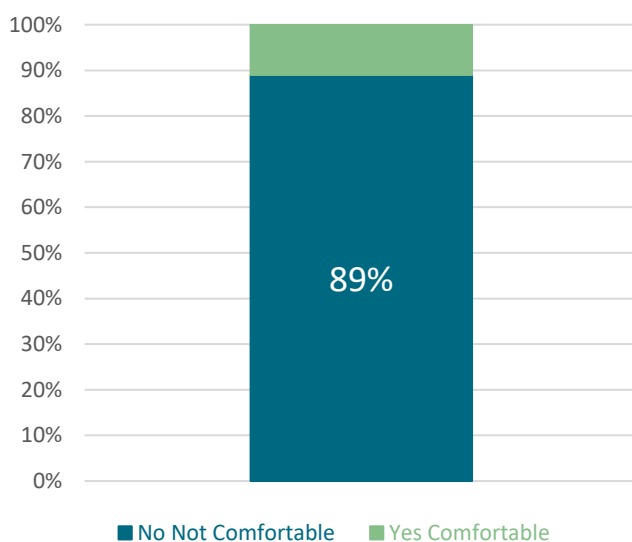
37% of respondents said they were dealing with more than one skin tumor, while 63% were dealing with a single tumor.

Question 3: Is the cancer located on an area of the body where scars or the appearance of the skin is a concern? This could include the ears, eyes, cheeks, forehead, lips, chin, scalp, or nose.



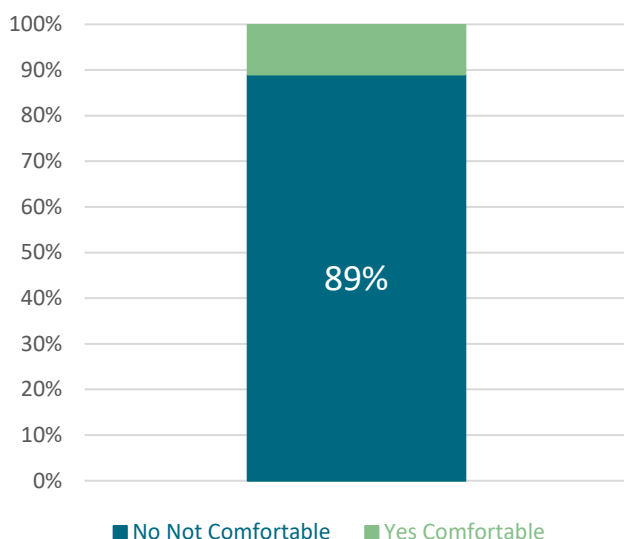
82% of respondents said the skin cancer was in an area of the body where scarring is a concern, while 18% said it was in an area where scarring is not a concern.

Question 4: Are you comfortable having surgery with a 1 in 3 chance that you will need reconstructive surgery afterward?



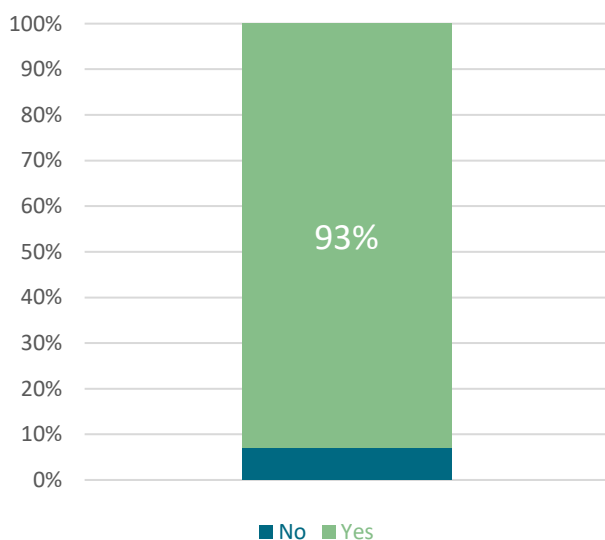
Knowing that there was a 1 in 3 chance of needing reconstruction, 89% of respondents were not comfortable having surgery, while only 11% were comfortable.

Question 5: Would you find comfort in being able to see the tumor shrink, so you know that treatment is working?



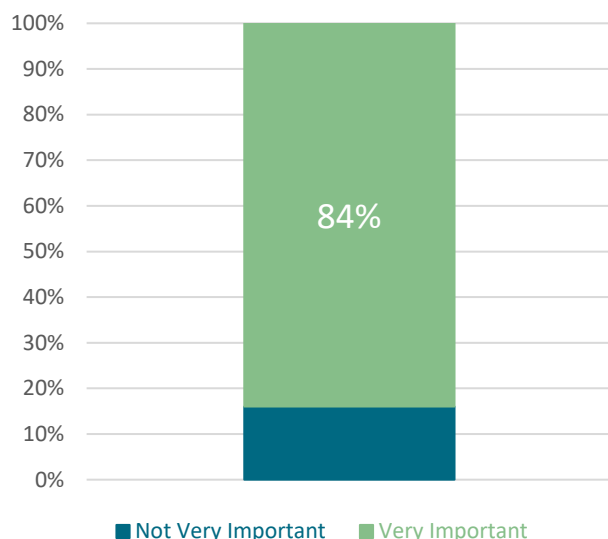
89% of respondents said they would find comfort in seeing the tumor shrink, so they would know the treatment is working.

Question 6: Do you have the time and transportation for multiple short visits to the doctor's office over the course of a few weeks?



93% of respondents said they would have the time and transportation needed for multiple short visits to the doctor's office over the course of a few weeks.

Question 7: How important is it for you to keep doing daily activities during and after treatment?



84% of respondents said it was important to be able to continue daily activities during and after treatment.
